# SA Health Forward Procurement Plan

The SA Health PSCM team has developed an ongoing Forward Procurement Plan (FPP) in partnership with the full range of internal stakeholders throughout the SA Health network including Department of Health and Wellbeing, Local Health Networks, SA Ambulance Service, statewide services and clinical support services. A wide range of factors are considered in determining which projects will be subject to an open market process in the forthcoming period. These include procurement policy and strategy, contractual requirements, risk management and a data driven approach to understanding key areas of spend.

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# Healthy Ideas Portal

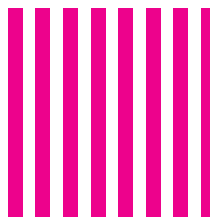
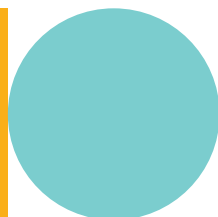

- > timely review and response to your idea submission by a panel of representatives from across SA Health;
- > the ability to track the status of your idea submission;
- > opportunities for engagement, co-design and potentially trialling your ideas in partnership with us; and
- > improved experience of communicating and working with SA Health.

The Healthy Ideas process is different and distinct from tender processes and official requests for information.

# Industry Roundtables

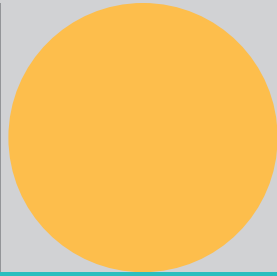
